WHAT DO WE KNOW ABOUT PATHOLOGICAL GAMBLING?

What is compulsive gambling?

Compulsive gambling, also known as gambling disorder, is the uncontrollable urge to keep gambling despite the toll it takes on your life. Gambling means that you are willing to risk something you value in the hope of winning something of even greater value.

This can stimulate the brain's reward system much like illicit drugs or alcohol can, leading to addiction. The most common forms of gambling within gambling disorder are games of chance, slot machines, sports betting and video games, among others.

Gambling addicts' beliefs:

There are two recurrent thoughts in gambling addicts that prevent them from giving up this behavior.

"I can quit whenever I want": each time they try to quit gambling, they relapse harder; every time they set a loss ceiling on a game, they cannot help but exceed it.

"If I've had a losing streak, my chances of winning on a next bet are increasing" (magical or superstitious thinking).



Symptoms:

- Needing to bet with increasing amounts of money to feel the same thrill.
- Trying to control, cut back or stop gambling, without success.
- Gambling to escape problems or relieve feelings of helplessness, guilt, anxiety or depression.
- Trying to recover lost money by betting more (chasing losses)
- Lying to family member or others to hide the extent of your gambling disorder.
- Risking or losing important relationships, a job, school or work opportunities because of gambling.

Pathological gambling (gambling disorder) can have profound and long-lasting consequences in your life, for example:

- Relationship problems
- Financial problems, such as bankruptcy
- Legal problems or imprisonment
- Poor work performance or job loss
- Poor general health
- Suicide, suicide attempts or suicidal thoughts

If you recognize these symptoms in yourself or in someone close to you, do not hesitate to ask for and offer support. Professional help is essential to overcome this type of disorder, as well as the emotional support of family and friends.

What does C.I. OROMETRO SAS do concerning this problem?

It provides constant training to its collaborators and offers psychological counseling through the ARL (Occupational Risk Insurer).

SAFETY OF CARGO UNITS AND CARGO TRANSPORTATION UNITS

C.I. OROMETRO S.A.S. has documents -within its Control and Security Management System- that state the guidelines to be followed by the operations team for verification of cargo units and armored vehicles that transport material, ensuring the proper implementation of controls on security issues and the identifications of any suspicious event that puts at risk the company's staff and/or cargo. Here are some tips that we must take into account to ensure the safety of cargo units and cargo transportation units.

- It is important that the person in charge of inspections has the necessary competence acquired through training, experience and skills.
- Inspections are aimed at detecting hidden compartment where potentially illicit items, such as weapons, drugs, or cash may be concealed.
- The route of each vehicle must be constantly monitored, and permanent contact with the driver must be maintained.
- Authorized stop-over sites must be available to stop vehicles in the event of any incident.
- Sites for overnight parking must be available and their security must be validated.
